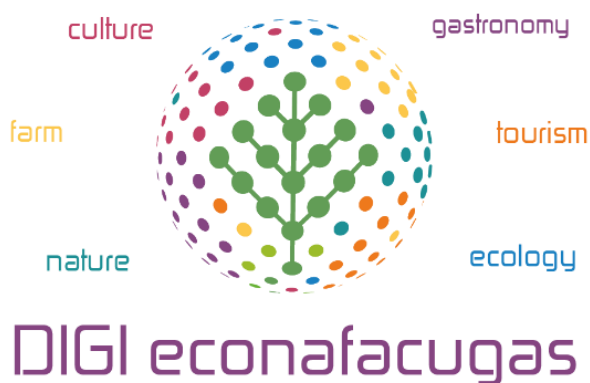


# Dissemination activities in the Erasmus+ Project

# Dissemination Activities in the Erasmus+ Project DIGI-ECONAFACUGAS

The Erasmus+ project DIGI-ECONAFACUGAS, focused on promoting the use of digital tools in ecological, cultural, and gastronomic rural tourism, featured a critical dissemination component carried out across the partner countries, including Romania, Spain, Austria, and Slovakia.

Each partner country organized dissemination events to showcase the project's outcomes and share examples of best practices.

These dissemination activities took place in each country, in face-to-face meetings but also online, as follows:

- Austria, on May 2, 2024, by Hochschule FUR AGRAR
- Romania, on June 3, 2024, by Propark - Foundation for Protected Areas
- Spain, on June 20, 2024, by CESEFOR and Fundacion Monte Mediterraneo
- Slovakia, on June 21, 2024, by Lišov Muzeum

These dissemination activities significantly impacted promoting the use of digital technologies in rural tourism, facilitating access and raising awareness among the general public about nature conservation and the sustainable development of rural communities.
